Directions to Lyons

Directions from Denver

- 1: Take US-36 W through BOULDER continue north towards LYONS. 14 miles.
- 2: At the Traffic Light Turn LEFT onto CO-7/US-36. Continue to follow CO-7/US-36. 1.25 miles

Directions from Rocky Mountain National Park

- 1: Take US-36 E. 20 miles
 - 2: Turn LEFT onto BROADWAY E. 0.33 miles
- Total Estimated Time: 31 minutes

From Fort Collins (CSU)

- 1: Take I-25 S/US-87 S toward DENVER. 26.1 miles
 - 2: Take the CO-66 exit- exit number 243- toward LONGMONT/LYONS
 - 3: Continue West on CO-66. 14.28 miles
 - 4: Continue Past Traffic Light on CO-7/US-36. 1.17 miles
- Total Estimated Time: 58 minutes

Once in Lyons

1. Turn South (left) on 3rd Avenue
2. Turn West (right) Railroad Ave and park on street across from Post Office


Your Booth/Canopy Location.

The attached layout map below will show a general location for your booth set-up. Use the map key to determine the location number assigned to you. The space allocated is approximately 10 foot by 10 foot area so please plan on using the appropriate sized canopy and tables. The event staff will mark off each location on the grass by the number assigned to you. Please locate event staff upon your arrival and they will assist you in finding your exact booth location and help you get settled. Please do this as there may be some changes between now and the date of the event.

Set-up of Your Booth/Canopy

The area will not be available for set up until 12:00 P.M. on Friday afternoon 6/12/09. You will be able to access your booth area by parking on Railroad Avenue and carrying your equipment to the assigned space. We will have volunteer helpers to assist you in moving your stuff to your spot. If you choose to set-up on Saturday we ask that you do so before 8:00 A.M. as the area will become congested with attendees and participants.

Do your absolute best to fasten your canopy down securely as the wind can really whip down the valley here and we don't want anybody to get hurt with flying tent parts or merchandise. Please use weights for you canopy instead of stakes. We ask that all exhibitors take care in assisting the Town of Lyons in protecting its parks by not driving on turf areas without prior permission and assistance, be mindful of sprinklers, and generally respect park rules.

Tear-Down

Security

Camping

Camping will be provided for free at Meadow Park to all sponsors, please call or e-mail Marissa Davis at 303-823-8250 or recreation@townoflyons.com with your reservation request as soon as possible. There are limited RV spots which will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. There are also many tent spaces. If you would like free camping, staff will leave a voucher for you at the Lyons Town Hall which may be picked up as early as 8 am on Thursday June 11th or the central registration table in Sandstone Park starting at 2 pm, or Saturday beginning at 8:00 am at the central registration area. Please let staff know how many nights you plan to stay and which type of space you prefer (RV or tent). We also need to know the number of individuals, number of tents/RV's, and associated number of vehicles that will be parking in Meadow Park to ensure that we accommodate you appropriately. Please show the Park Host your camping permit once received and enjoy your stay.
